

Hunting Trip Gear List



Plan to wear clothing in layers that can be easily added and removed. Be prepared for 40°F to 55°F during the spring bear hunts, 30°F to 55°F during fall goat hunts, and 10°F to 35°F during the fall bear and deer hunts.

Please pack your gear in several soft waterproof duffel bags rather than a large suitcase for bush plane transport. Use the following list as you pack. Remember, most clients bring too much gear.

All Gear must be either synthetic, wool, or treated down. No Cotton.

Base Layer - 2 tops & bottoms

Ultra Merino 145 or 210 (Kuiu)
Core or Merino (Sitka Gear)

Active Mid layer - 1 top

Dri-Climb Wind shirt (Marmot)
Traverse Hoody (Sitka Gear)

Non active mid layer - 1 top

Compressor Jacket (Mountain Hardwear)
Super Down Hooded Jacket (Kuiu)
Super Down Vest (Kuiu)

Outer Layer - 1 bottom

Mountain Pant (Sitka Gear) early season
Timberline Pant (Sitka Gear) late season
Attack Pant (Kuiu) early season
Guide Pant (Kuiu) late season

Rain Gear - 1 top & bottom

Cloudburst Jacket & Pants (Sitka Gear)
Chugach or Yukon Jacket & Pants (Kuiu)
3/4 Lgth Impertech Jacket (Helly Hansen)

Gloves - liner and shell

Super Down Glassing Mitt (Kuiu)
Ultra Merino 210 Glove (Kuiu)
Yukon Glove (Kuiu)

Boots

Mountain Extreme (Kenetrek)
Hunter GTX aka The Sheep Hunter (Lowa)
Big Chief Insulated Hipboots (Lacrosse)
River Trekker Overboots (Neo Overshoe)

Socks

3 x sock and liner combinations

Bed Roll - only for spike camps

NeoAir Xlite (Thermarest)
NeoAir Xtherm (Thermarest)

Sleeping Bag - only for spike camps

15° Ultra lamina (Mountain Hardwear)
15° Phantom (Mountain Hardwear)
15° Super Down Bag (Kuiu)
